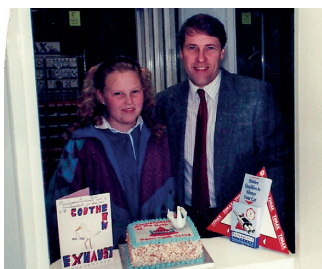

## THE LISA WILSON SCHOLARSHIP FUND

The Lisa Wilson Scholarship Fund is a registered charity started after the death of Lisa Wilson, daughter of the owners of SES Autoparts Clive and Tricia Wilson.

Lisa was tragically killed in a car crash on November 4th 2002 whilst travelling to Ayres rock in Australia. The year before Lisa had graduated from Southampton Institute-now Southampton Solent University- with a BA 2-1 Honours in Business Management. Lisa's reward to herself for doing so well at Uni was a trip around the world it was on this journey living her dream she sadly died.

Following Lisa's death the Wilson family Clive, Tricia, Scott and Ross decided to start the charity to keep Lisa's memory alive. The charity provides young adults who have overcome adversity or who can demonstrate why they need additional funding with a bursary of £1000 per annum for up to three years. The intention of this is to help them fulfil their educational dreams and ambitions in the same way that Lisa did.

To date the family has raised over £270,000, this has now become Lisa's Legacy, 270 years of education as every £1000 represents a year in a student's life. Some ninety students have now benefited from the bursaries. For many it has been a life changing event. One of the first recipients Charlotte Field-now Lystor -has subsequently become a tutor at Winchester University. 'This would never have been possible without the additional support from the Wilson family' said Charlotte, "my success is just one of the stories of the ninety students who have benefited from the charity'.

Lisa was a fun loving girl who lived life to the full, on her trip around the world she carried out one of the biggest bungy jumps in the world at Queenstown in New Zealand and also did a free-fall parachute jump. She loved to dance and was a Saints season ticket holder.

The Wilson family would like to take this opportunity to thank everyone who has supported the charity over the years.
